

Risk Assessment – St Georges Day parade

Hazard	Who might be harmed?	Control Measures
Vehicle collision	Vehicle passengers Other road users /pedestrians	The Leaders who is to drive to the event will be using a car they are familiar with. All vehicles are fitted with seat belts
Breakdown - inability to attend event	All on transport	Vehicles provided with full breakdown cover. Alternative car is available if breakdown occurs before leaving from base
Walking along road / pavement	All involved	Group to walk in a manner so as not to obstruct path or pavement for other users Due to small party, leaders to walk behind scouts to ensure no one becomes detached from party
Crossing road	All crossing road	Official crossing points (zebra crossings etc.) to be used where possible. Where these are not available leaders should supervise crossing of the road in a safe manner Head count to be taken before leaving for home
Person becomes detached from group	All involved	Each member of party to have a laminated card with group details and leaders mobile phone number
General	All involved	All on parade to wear sensible footwear All leaders have first response level of first aid
