Hazard	Who might be harmed?	Control Measures
Slipping hazards: access to and from String Trail	All involved	Pre-briefing warning participants and helpers of slippery conditions.
		Adequate lighting and safety tapes so as Explorers & Scouts can see where they are allowed.
General	All involved	Supervision at all times.  If necessary Explorers & Scouts should be taken back to base.
		String should not be too thin, so as not to cut hands
String trail	All involved	When laying out and using string trail avoid going through brambles, sharp objects and very steep ditches/banks. Check ground for these and make sure trees are safe and will not fall on participants
		Look where you are walking
